Questions, Answers and Notification:

Question: Vendor is requesting to lower our insurance requirements.

Specifically, they are asking if \$2 million general aggregate insurance policy would

be sufficient for this transaction

of liability in an amount of not less than \$5,000,000 per occurrence and in the

aggregate.

Question: Vendor is requesting to change five (5) USB ports in front of both the

small form and tower configurations to four (4) USB ports.

Answer: As per our IT Department, there will be no changes to our

specifications. (5) USB ports in front of both the small form and tower

configurations.

Question: Shall we submit separate proposals based on promotional pricing if the

PO award can be issued within 30 days, or our regular proposal valid

for 120 days?





Answer: No.

Question: Do you require us to submit our proposing specs of the products ahead of

time matching to NICE V-2375 Specs for your approval?

Answer: No

Question: In consideration of the computers being furnished, do you need additional

service for installation & setup?

Answer: No.

Question: Since the RFQ due date is March 5, would you accept our early submission to receive

your PO award confirmation, even if the PO process may take up to 120 days?

Question: The vendor is requesting confirmation that the i7 workstation will be a

tower. Additionally, could you please revise the specification to reflect a

chassis size with a height of 6 inches?

Answer: As per our IT Department, yes it will be a tower. The approximate

dimensions are: Height 13.5", Depth 11", and Width between 5.8" and

6.1".

Question: Do both of these workstations have Wi-Fi capability?

Answer: Wi-Fi is not required.
